Community update - November 2018

Dear resident

Kaimai Wind Farm's proposal to construct a wind farm on the northern reaches of the Kaimai Ranges is finally open for public submission.

Research into the suitability of the Tirohia site dates back to 2005 with a huge raft of studies and analyses conducted over subsequent years.

An Assessment of Environmental Effects ("AEE") was lodged with the Hauraki District and Waikato Regional Councils and has now been publicly notified, enabling the public to make submissions until 31 January 2019.
